Urgent: Protect Your Child from Lead Poisoning - Act Now!

Dear Parents & Guardians,

Lead is toxic, and exposure can cause serious, lifelong health problems—especially for young children. Even small amounts can harm brain development, learning, and behavior. The danger is often hidden in older homes (built before 1978), peeling paint, and household dust.

● Don't wait until it's too late! A simple blood test can detect lead poisoning before it causes lasting damage. If your child is under 6 living or visiting often during the week in a home built before 1978, talk to your doctor about testing right away.

🏠 Need help making your home lead-safe? The City of Bloomington has a grant-funded program offering FREE home lead testing and hazard control—but time is running out! Funds are limited, and applications must be submitted ASAP.
