Subject: Upcoming Construction – Roadway Milling and Resurfacing

Dear Residents,

Beginning **Friday, August 8**, construction crews will resume pavement work throughout Meadowbrook Subdivision. This stage of the project will involve milling approximately 2” from the existing pavement, followed by placement of an asphalt surface. After the new pavement is installed, a curing period of approximately 2 hours will be required before traffic resumes.

Work will begin daily at 7:00 a.m.

Please note the following important details:

- **Driveway Access:** All residents may temporarily lose access to their driveways during construction. Please allow for extra time to coordinate with the contractor’s workers and equipment.
- **No On-Street Parking:** If possible, and based on the contractor’s schedule, on street parking will be restored between the milling and resurfacing operations.
- **Traffic Access:** During construction, traffic will be permitted throughout Meadowbrook Subdivision, in cooperation with the contractor’s operations.
- **Staged Construction:** Crews will work on one side of the street at a time to help maintain access for residents.

We anticipate the project will take approximately **3 to 4 weeks** to complete, weather permitting.

Please drive slowly and cautiously, and we appreciate your patience and cooperation as we work to continue improvements of your roadways. **Safety is our top priority.**
